The following items were discussed:

Membership Committee

- John Bonsee briefed the MLC received 89 inquiries of interest at our booth during the Annual Seminar. These included 12 military, 9 governmental, 27 security professionals, 4 international, and 40 others from a variety of categories. John briefed he will send out letters to each of the prospects next week.

Emerging Trends in Security Seminar

- Joe Rector briefed that he submitted our session proposal to ASIS HQ on 15 October. The proposal is for a 90 minute session and includes all five military services, the National Guard Bureau and the Canadian Armed Forces. The proposal agenda outlines a five introduction and a 15 minute question and answer period. This allows each presenter 10 minutes to cover their service/agency emerging trend.
- The Emerging Trends in Security Seminar will be held 19-21 May 08 in Las Vegas.

26th Annual Government/Industry Conference on Global Terrorism

- The MLC will be presenting a 90 minute session on 18 Mar 08 at 1530 hours. Mr. Geoffroy had previously provided information that the session will include a 30 minute presentation by the NGB on military support to WMD mitigation and a 30 minute presentation by Sam Brinkley on the public security challenge to the WMD threat.
- Col Tom McGinley briefed he can tailor his presentation to cover national guard operations in general or more specific to military police and security forces.
- The Global Terrorism Conference will be held 17-19 Mar 08 at the Ritz-Carlton Pentagon City, Alexandria, VA.

- David Ramirez briefed he received a lot of positive feedback and support for our military appreciation initiatives at the Annual Seminar.
- The San Antonio and Dallas Chapters have expressed interest in sponsoring annual events in their respective areas. David Ramirez is building a template for a recognition event to assist them in their efforts.
