### **MLC Membership:**

The council voted to add Mr. Mark Allen, Director of Security Forces for the Air Force District of Washington, to the MLC. The council also welcomed Col Steve Robinette, Commander, Air Force Security Forces Center, as the new senior USAF representative. John Bonsee will follow-up with a Nigerian intelligence officer who has expressed interest in joining the MLC.

### **ASIS Marketing/Business Case Study:**

Greg Steele asked all service reps provide ballpark estimates on the total number of security and law enforcement professionals (military, civilian, and contractor) in their respective service. These numbers will be used as part of the business case study with ASIS on reducing costs for military members. Service reps should forward the numbers to Joe Rector. Joe briefed he has received inputs from the USAF, USCG and US Navy. **POST MEETING ADDENDUM:** USMC has submitted their numbers.

### **Annual Seminar Proposals:**

Joe Rector reminded members of our MLC proposals for presentations on “Emerging Trends in Military Security” and “Military Security Operations in Iraq/Afghanistan.” The proposals follow the format as last year. “Emerging Trends” will be 2-60 minute sessions and the “Military

Security Operations” in Iraq/Afghanistan will be 2-90 minute sessions. Joe briefed that he listed many of the service reps as placeholder speakers in order to meet the initial ASIS requirement and we will adjust to reflect the correct speaker as we get closer to the seminar in Sep. He also briefed that he had received speaker inputs from the USAF. Joe also briefed to expect the presentations to be due to ASIS in mid-August.

### **President’s Reception Cigar Lounge Proposal**

Joe Rector briefed that our proposal to host the cigar lounge at the President’s Reception at the Annual Seminar was not approved. The lounge would have served as a joint fund raiser for the ASIS Foundation and the Warriors to Work Program. ASIS was unable to obtain approval from Disney to sell the cigars on their properties.

### **MLC Newsletter:**

Joe Rector asked that the service reps and Military Appreciation Chair provide him inputs NLT 30 Mar 09. From the service reps he is looking for any military security and law enforcement activities/endeavors that may be of interest to the general ASIS membership. So far he has received inputs from the USAF and USCG.

### **Military Transition:**

Joe Gulinello suggested we link up with the Law Enforcement Liaison Council concerning their transition initiatives. The MLC discussed how to get ASIS involved in the military transition process. Greg Steele will host a teleconference of key members to discuss options on 12 March at 1200 hours to discuss further. David Martin will make arrangements for the teleconference. David Ramirez will work to see if he can link up the Warriors-to-Work jobs website with the TAonline.com website which focuses on military transition.

### **2010 Global Terrorism Conference:**

The Global Terrorism, Political Instability and International Crime Council invited the MLC to participate in their 2010 spring seminar which will focus on international instability. The council agreed there is ample ground for our participation. Council members are asked to begin thinking about potential topics and speakers. Tim Carruth will follow-up on some potential speakers he heard at a recent AFRICOM conference.
