Annual Seminar Update:

- The MLC will hold our annual meeting on Sunday, 20 September, 1700-1900 hours, at the conference center in Anaheim. Room location TBD.

- Joe Rector briefed that ASIS will be holding Law Enforcement/Military Appreciation Day on Wednesday, 23 Sep 09 at the Annual Seminar. Military/LE personnel can attend that day free of charge. Joe asked that all service representatives disseminate the information to military installations in the Anaheim area. He previously distributed the ASIS press release on the appreciation day to the MLC members and will do so again during the distribution of the minutes.

- Wednesday/23 September/1100-1200/ASIS Certifications 101 for the Military (to be presented by Joe Rector and Brent Belcoff).
- **Wednesday/23 September**/1330-1500/Military Security Operations in Iraq/Afghanistan (Part 2 – USAF, NGB, CF, Q&A).
 - Each service presenter will have approximately 20 minutes for their presentation.

Military Transition:

- Greg Steele discussed that latest from the Council's Military Transition Committee. The committee discussed several ideas to include sponsoring a majoring transitioning event. One idea is sponsor/organize a major transition event targeting military personnel. Council members discussed this concept. Jeff Geoffroy suggested that this would only be able to target a very limited population. It would be better to encourage chapters to hold transition events in their local areas or participate in military transition programs at the installations. Also, members liked the concept of an ASIS transition video which would be distributed to the installations for their use in their transition programs. Greg asked that if any other members had any additional inputs or feedback to send it to him by COB 15 June.

- Joe Rector briefed that ASIS is creating a webpage to specifically market to military personnel. The site will promote security certifications and education as well as transition to the private sector. Members expressed an interest in reviewing the site content. Joe briefed he would obtain a copy and distribute it to the members for comment and review.

- Joe Rector briefed he is still working the council newsletter. He has inputs from the Air Force and Coast Guard, but would like something from the other services. Any information that would be interesting to the ASIS membership at large is encouraged.
