Abdulaziz F. Al-Khayyal is Senior Vice President, Industrial Relations. He was appointed to this position September 1, 2007. As head of the Industrial Relations business line, he is responsible for many of the company's most vital support operations, including human resources and training, safety and security, government and public relations, community services, and medical services.

Abdulaziz joined the company in 1981 as an engineer. He has held a variety of managerial positions in oil and gas operations and maintenance. In 1991, he was appointed Director of Personnel, and in 1993 he was appointed President of Saudi Petroleum International, Inc., New York. In 1994, he was appointed President of the Petron Corporation, Saudi Aramco's refining joint venture in the Philippines. On his return to the Kingdom, Abdulaziz was appointed Vice President of Sales and Marketing, and then Vice President, Employee Relations and Training, and then Vice President, Corporate Planning, in 1998.

In 2000 he was appointed Senior Vice President, International Operations. In 2003, he became Senior Vice President, Refining, Marketing and International. In 2004, Mr. Al-Khayyal was appointed to the Board of Directors of Saudi Aramco and to PetroRabigh in 2005.

Abdulaziz is a graduate of the University of California, Irvine, where he received a B.S. degree in Mechanical Engineering in 1977 and a Master's degree in Business Administration in 1979. He attended the company's Management Development Seminar in 1986 and the Advanced Management Program at the University of Pennsylvania in 1995.
