January 3

Applications accepted for Alan J. Cross Award

The Cross Award pays registration fees for 20 members to attend an ASIS certification review course of their choice. Applications must be signed by a chapter officer. Members cannot nominate themselves.

January 3

Applications accepted for Chapter Matching Scholarships

Make the most of your local chapter's scholarship program. These awards provide matching funds for an education award to a chapter member or college student. If a scholarship is awarded to a chapter member, the Foundation doubles the award, up to \$1,000. If a scholarship is awarded to a student, the Foundation matches the amount up to \$500 for the first 30 applications.

Applications accepted for Roy Bordes Physical Security Award

Apply for a customized, two-day physical security education program for your chapter. Annually, one ASIS chapter is honored with the Roy Bordes Physical Security Award, which pays toward the cost of instructors, their travel and accommodations, and collateral materials.
