zebra line - a line usually drawn on a floor to designate an area that can only be entered after particular conditions have been met; restricted area which requires special safety equipment.

zip gun - a homemade gun; illegal single-shot pistol; constructed of a short length of pipe attached to the frame of a cap gun or toy, with a firing mechanism made of a nail head and elastic (rubber) bands.

zone - a section of an alarmed, protected, or patrolled area. A zone often means a space having one or more sensors.

zone of influence - area of a distribution system that is impacted by a chemical contamination event.

zone expander - a device that allows more than one individual zone to be monitored over a single pair of wires. The device is armed and powered from a main controller.

zone search -

zoom lens - a single lens with a variable focal range.

zoom ratio - the ratio between the longest and shortest focal length of a single lens.
