PSP Item Development Group to Meet in September

The PSP Item Development Group (IDG) will meet September 15 -19 in Dallas, TX to write, edit, and update exam questions. The IDG will consist of the PCB Test Management Committee and security professionals who are certified as PSPs and CPPs (CPP participants have a background in physical security). Each group will be trained in question writing by the PES program director for ASIS.

New Reference for PCI Adopted

The Professional Investigator's Manual has been adopted by the Professional Certification Board (PCB) as the sole source for the PCI exam. The new single-volume reference replaces the six-book *PCI Reference Set* (ASIS Bookstore Item #1696); both resources contain the same core knowledge required for PCI exam preparation. Candidates may use either *The Professional Investigator's Manual* or the *PCI Reference Set* to study. Important Recertification Reminder

If you are due to recertify by December 31, 2010, please submit your recertification documentation before the deadline to avoid any delays. Please note that the office will be closed from December 24 until December 31, 2010. If your designation has fallen under the lapse policy, you still have a chance to reinstate it before December 31, 2010. Please visit the lapse policy online for more details.

New Security Measures at Prometric Testing Centers

Prometric has implemented a new security check-in process for all candidates testing at their locations. Testing staff are not allowed to pat a candidate down during the check-in process. However, they will be using a security wand (similar to those used at airports) to check candidates for any type of cheating devices. This is in addition to having the candidates turn their pockets inside out.

ASIS 2010 CPE Credit Information

Earn 19 Recertification Credits

If you're a CPP, PCI, or PSP, earning your required credits has never been easier or more affordable! You can earn up to 19 recertification CPEs by attending the Annual Seminar and Exhibits.

1. Those who register for the full Seminar (4 days) will automatically receive sixteen (16) CPE credits plus three (3) CPE credits for attendance at the exhibit hall. (No documentation is required.)
2. Those who register for a single day registration will automatically receive four (4) CPE credits plus three (3) CPE credits for attendance at the exhibit hall.
3. Those who register as exhibits-only can claim three (3) CPE credits (copy of the name badge is required as a form of documentation).
4. Those who attend as exhibitors can claim three (3) CPE credits and one (1) CPE credit per session that they attend. (Copy of the name badge is required as a form of documentation).

Certification exams will not be offered during ASIS 2010 as most international candidates can now register to take their exams in their country of residence via computer-based test (CBT) administration.
