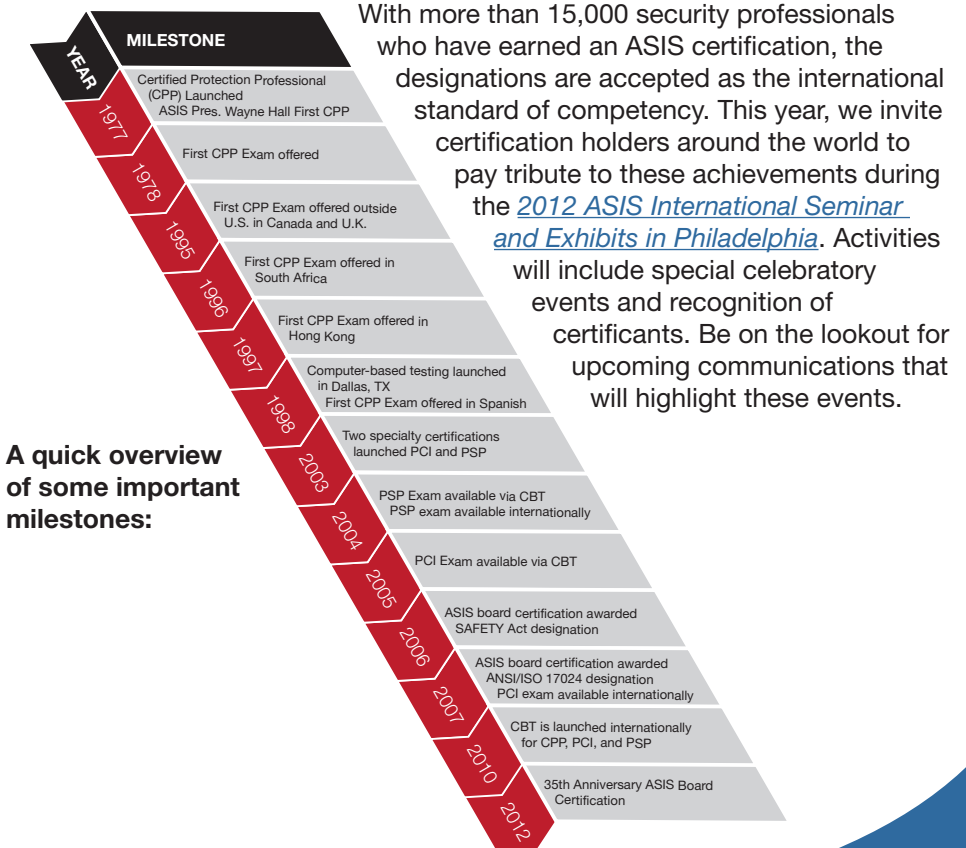

PSP Eligibility At- A-Glance

Eligibility Requirements Include Higher Education

Applicants holding a Bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited institution may qualify with a minimum of four (4) years of progressive physical-security experience.

Note: Applicants with a high school diploma, GED equivalent, or Associate's degree may qualify with six (6) years of progressive physical-security experience. View more [details](#) about the PSP program.

Important Reminders!

Recertification

- Certificants who are due to recertify by 12/31/12 may submit activities accomplished during 2010, 2011, and 2012. Please remember to fill out a recertification form and submit this along with the appropriate supporting documentation. The form and more detailed information is available via this [link](#).
- Certificants who were due to recertify 12/31/11, but did not, now fall under the lapsed policy. You have until 12/31/12 to submit your required documentation. Please visit [this site](#) for more details.

Updated CPP and PCI Test Forms

Beginning November 2012 – Administration of Updated CPP and PCI Exam Forms! The PCB recently completed the process of preparing new test forms for the CPP and PCI exam. All exams are updated periodically to prevent overexposure of test forms. Please note that there is no change in the exam eligibility requirements or domains of study.

Consolidation of CPP Reference Materials

Included in the CPP program updating is the consolidation of CPP reference materials. The Protection of Assets (POA) Manual will continue to be a reference source and ASIS Standards and Guidelines will replace other publications. However, legal references for Canada and UK will remain in effect.

All questions on the exams will be taken from the reference books so it is important to note this change! See updated list below:
