*Beginning November 2012 – Administration of Updated CPP and PCI Exam Forms!*

### Updated CPP and PCI Test Forms

The PCB recently completed the process of preparing new test forms for the CPP and PCI exam. All exams are updated periodically to prevent overexposure of test forms. Please note that there is no change in the exam eligibility requirements or domains of study.

### Consolidation of CPP Reference Materials

Included in the CPP program updating is the consolidation of CPP reference materials. *Protection of Assets (POA)* will continue to be a reference source and selected ASIS Standards and Guidelines will replace other publications. However, legal references for Canada and UK will remain in effect.

*All questions on the exams will be taken from the reference materials so it is important to note this change! See updated list below:*
