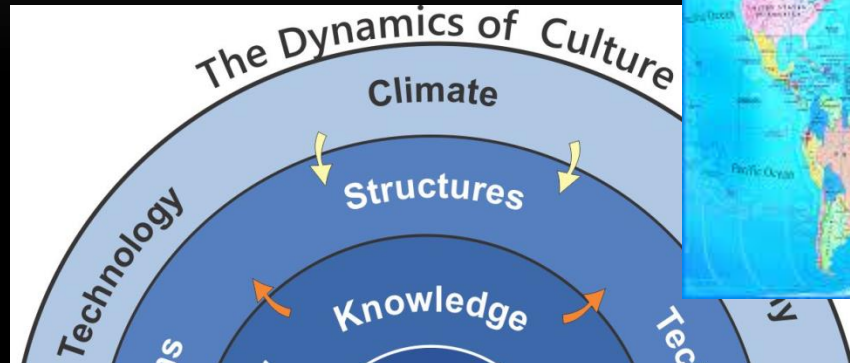

 Observable behaviours
 e.g. Symbols, Slogans, Published list of values

Espoused Beliefs and Values

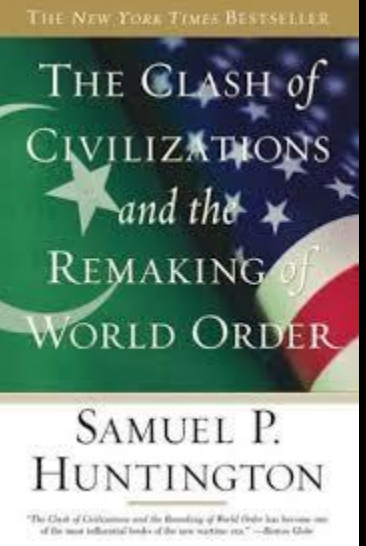
Ideologies, Goals, Aspirations
 May not be consistent with "Published Values"
 Validated by shared experience

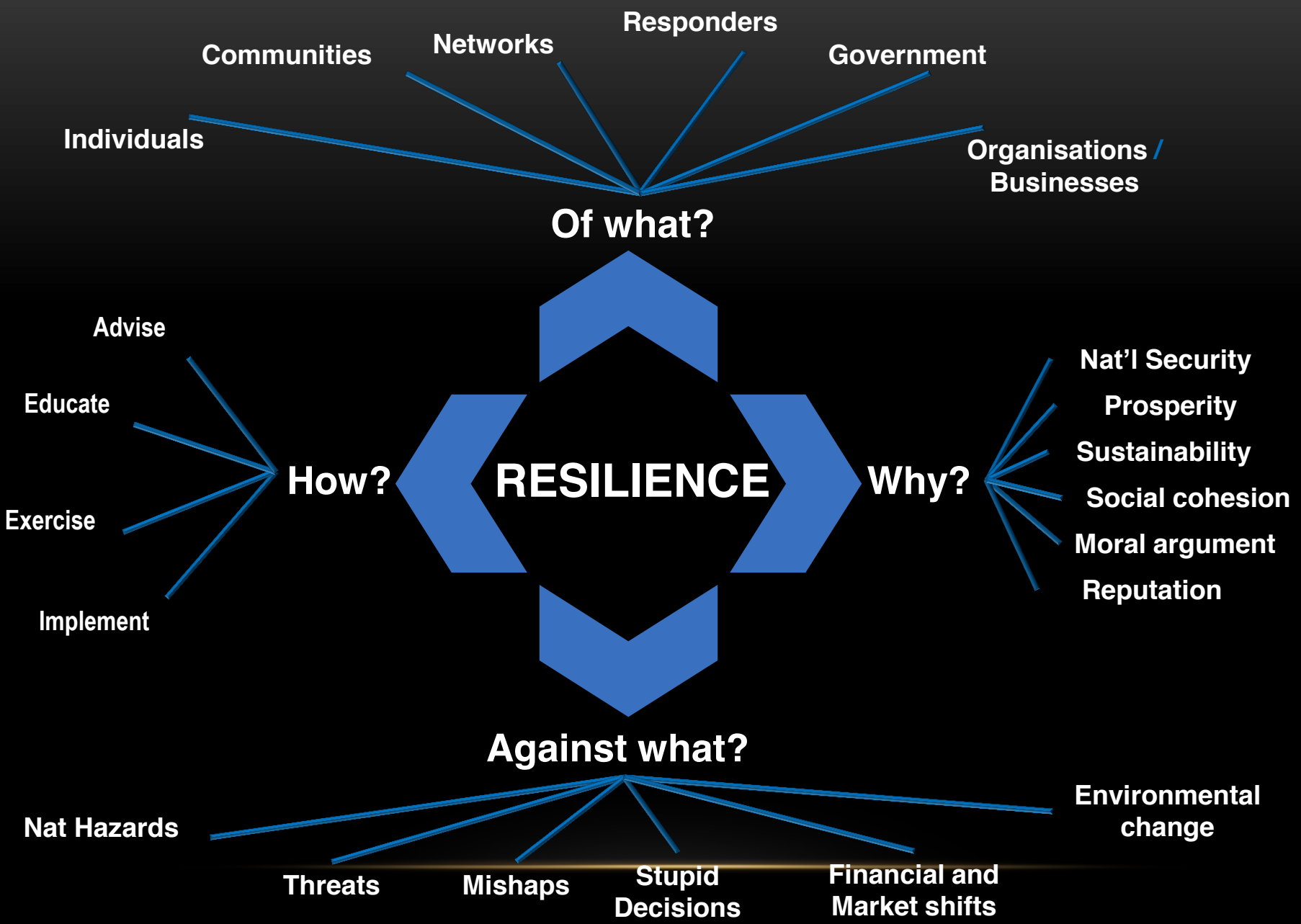
Basic Underlying Assumptions

Unconscious, taken-for-granted beliefs and values

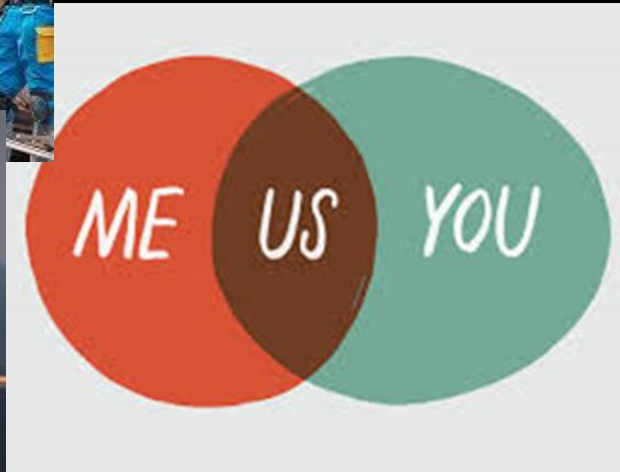
