### ASIS Singapore Chapter CPP Review Course in March

The ASIS International Singapore Chapter will organize a CPP review course and advanced security management program in Singapore from 27-30 March.

The CPP review is primarily designed for CPP candidates. Others who may find the program useful include security practitioners who wish to enhance their security knowledge, executives who have assumed security management responsibilities, and individuals who wish to gain security management knowledge.

Over 4 days, the course will cover:

- Security Principles & Practices and Investigations
- Emergency Practices and Personnel Security
- Physical Security
- Information Security and Business Principles & Practices

The fee for the review program is \$2,000 SGD net, inclusive of course materials, all lunches and tea breaks over the course duration. Singapore Chapter members are entitled to a 10% discount, and other members from ASIS will benefit from a 5% discount off the course fee.

The registration deadline is 24 February.

Foreign businessmen in the Philippines are beginning to doubt the ability of local authorities to ensure their safety, following reports that high-ranking police were behind the kidnap-slay of Korean businessman Jee Ick-joo at police headquarters in Camp Crame last October. "We promote trade and investment between their respective countries and regions in both directions, but can only succeed in their mission if peace and order and safety can be guaranteed by the authorities," the Joint Foreign Chambers (JFC) of the Philippines said in a statement over the weekend. "The kidnapping and brutal killing of Jee Ick-joo puts these expected guarantees in question," the group stressed.

Members of the JFC - the American, Australian-New Zealand, European and Japanese chambers - said they fully support the concerns expressed by the Korean Chamber of Commerce Philippines (KCCP) over the kidnapping and murder of Jee and, in general, "the safety of local and foreign businessmen and residents at large in the Philippines."

The move comes months after officials for the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP) signaled their intention to regulate exchanges, suggesting at the time that they would class the businesses as a form of remittance company.
