Pillai's session focused on how fraud is managed in the corporate environment. His presentation described a nonconventional approach to handling corporate frauds, as well as identifying red flags in the early stages. Pillai touched upon various legal aspects of fraud management and the numerous challenges faced by security professionals in its detection and investigation. He also emphasized the importance of leadership commitment to fraud management and in safeguarding an organization from fraud and other related reputational risks by adopting a proactive approach in fraud detection.

This was followed by a keynote address by Dr. Shailesh Ayyangar, managing director and vice president at Sanofi. Ayyangar, a veteran with more than three decades of experience in the pharma industry, shared his view on security from a CEO's perspective. He emphasized the importance of security in an organization and how security is structured at Sanofi. His thoughts on corporate security, its importance and the impact it creates on the overall business resonated with the group and left them inspired, motivated, and encouraged to take on security challenges.



The final educational session was a panel discussion on managing women's safety and security in the corporate environment. Moderated by Percy Jokhi, security head, CMS and Pankaj Dhotre, Mumbai Police, and panelists Usha Suryavanshi, ATS, Maharashtra Police; Anubha Rastogi, Justice and Care; Supreet Kaur, Safecity.in; Sagarika Chakroborty, IIRIS; and Seema Sakpal, BDB. The discussion was focused on the sexual harassment of women at the workplace and also covered concerns faced by female employees beyond the working environment. The panel discussed various ways of creating a safe workplace for women. Panelists from the police and the NGO spoke about their roles in managing harassment cases. Various best practices adopted by their organizations were shared by the panelists.

Paul Devassy, ASIS assistant regional vice president, thanked the speakers, host Pramod Bhatt, and his entire team at Sanofi for hosting the event. After the meeting a high tea was held for attendees to network.

South Korea Launches First Internet of Things Network



South Korea has launched its first commercial, low-cost Internet of Things (IoT) network aimed at making the country even more connected. The network would allow smart devices to talk to each other via the network. Phone carrier SK Telecom is behind the initiative, which uses technology that will allow it to reach 99 percent of the country's population. Besides South Korea, The Netherlands also has a nationwide IoT network.

Malaysia Bar Blast is First Islamic State Attack



Malaysian police have said a blast at a bar last week, which injured eight, was the first attack by the so-called Islamic State (IS) group in the country. Police initially said that business rivalry was a more likely motive for the attack on the Movida Bar and Restaurant outside Kuala Lumpur on June 28. They added that two men suspected of involvement had been arrested. Authorities are increasingly concerned about IS-related attacks as a number of Malaysians have gone to fight in Syria. "There were elements of IS involvement in the attack," National Police Chief Khalid Abu Bakar told reporters.

Dhaka Cafe Attack Leaves 20 Dead

Bangladeshi Prime Minister Shiekh Hasina has announced two days of national mourning after an attack on a cafe in Dhaka left 28 people dead, including 20 hostages, most of whom were killed with sharp weapons. In a televised address to the nation following the attack in the diplomatic quarter of the Bangladesh's capital in which six militants and two police officers were killed, she called for unity against criminal elements. Thirteen people were rescued when more than 100 Bangladeshi commandos stormed the Holey Artisan Bakery after a 12-hour siege.

Philippines Police Boast about Killings Since Duterte Came to Power

Thirty purported drug dealers have been killed since Rodrigo Duterte was sworn in as Philippine president, police said while announcing the seizure of nearly U.S. \$20m (£15m) worth of narcotics. The announcement sparked anger from a lawyers' group, however. Duterte won the election in May on a platform of crushing crime, but his incendiary rhetoric and advocacy of extrajudicial killings have alarmed many who hear echoes of the country's authoritarian past.

ASIS Europe 2017: Save the Date




ASIS Europe 2017 will take place from March 29 to 31, 2017, at the MiCo Conference Centre in central Milan, Italy.
