### New Format for ASIS Europe 2017 Draws Security Leaders to Milan

ASIS Europe 2017 - From Risk to Resilience took place in Milan, Italy on 29-31 March.

The event theme "Secure Today's Connected Enterprise" brought together CSOs, CISOs, and their team members to assess and address complex cyber-physical risks.

With 700 registrants from 48 countries, this was an impressive crowd of both established and aspiring security leaders with many global enterprises represented.

The breadth and depth of the learning opportunities, spanning 75 sessions across 6 stages in 2 days helped draw a diverse audience. This provided a platform for the exchange of ideas across critical infrastructure, manufacturing, and financial services, to digital enterprises such as Facebook and Paypal plus the public sector, particularly municipalities, keen to learn from corporate experience.

A new event format saw the launch of both the ASIS Europe Career Centre and Training Workshops. These were designed to provide education and career advancement opportunities relevant to a wide range of professionals, regardless of experience, background, or financial resources.

As part of the new concept for the ASIS Europe event, Andy Williams, CPP, and Roger Warwick, CPP, led a training session on "How to Structure and Implement a Travel Risk Management Programme" to a packed room.

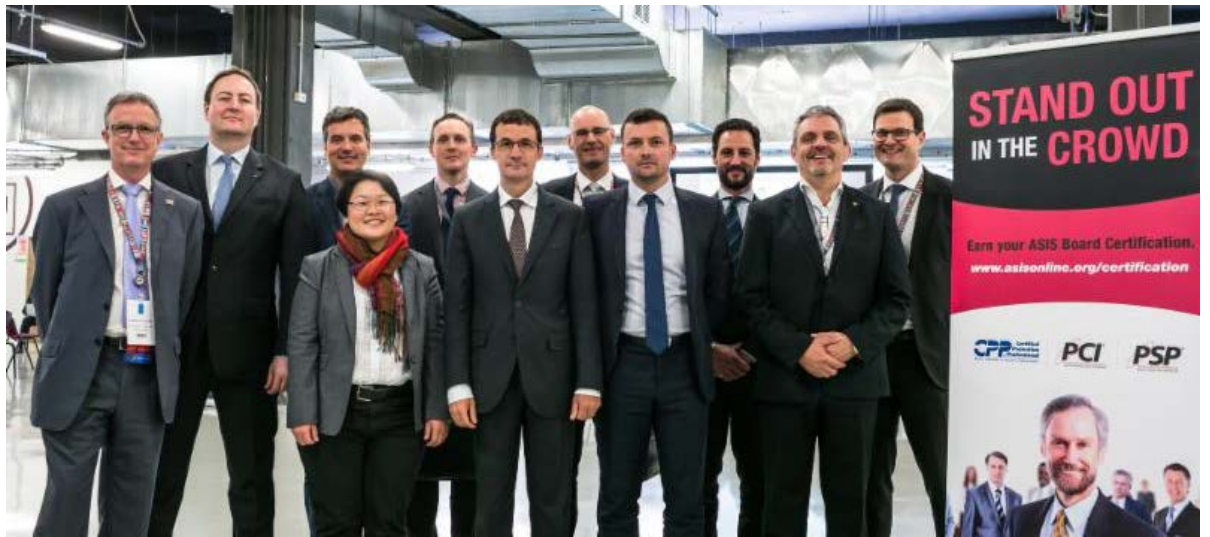
Participants were shown how to make the case for Travel Risk Management (TRM) to corporate management, whatever the size of the organisation; how to set up and run a TRM department; and how to perform risk assessments.

The area is now more relevant than ever because corporate manslaughter and duty of care are no longer considered exclusive to "safety" and are now in the mainstream of security management tasks. TRM is a topical subject around Europe but especially so in Italy where, the day before the training, the CEO and four other managers of an Italian construction company were charged with criminal negligence following the kidnapping of four employees in Libya, two of whom died. The precise charge in the case is "lack of taking security measures."

After the training session, enthusiastic comments were received from many of the participants.

## UK Chapter Welcomes Foreign and Commonwealth Office Security Team

The ASIS International UK Chapter is always pleased to welcome new members and is doing so on an increasingly regular basis. This year, for example, nine new members joined from Amazon and are currently studying for their CPP certifications. However, the biggest influx so far this year comes not from a commercial organisation, but from the UK Government.

The Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO), which employs more than 14,000 people in nearly 270 diplomatic offices, wanted to accredit its security professionals and, after researching all the various security membership organisations, approached ASIS in the UK to discuss how their team could join.

ASIS UK Chapter Vice Chairs Mike Hurst and Graham Bassett led the process and, following meetings with the FCO in the UK and with the ASIS leadership in the US, the chapter is delighted to welcome almost 40 new ASIS members from the FCO. This number is likely to increase over the next few months. It is also expected that many of these security professionals will undertake ASIS certifications (CPP, PSP, and PCI) as well.

This initiative shows how seriously the FCO takes its security responsibilities, and the fact they chose ASIS International speaks volumes for the Glocal (Global yet Local) reach of the association.

## EU Overview

### Laptop Ban 'Intolerable' for Airlines



The US and UK bans on laptops on flights from countries in the Middle East has helped create an "intolerable" situation for aviation, which has already been rocked by a number of shocks this year, said the head of the industry's world governing body. Alexandre de Juniac, the International Air Transport Association's chief executive, said that such policy decisions, made without consulting airlines, have added to the uncertainties facing the sector and risked damaging public confidence.

Sixteen European Union countries including powerful Germany and France have launched plans to create an EU public prosecutor's office to combat fraud, the bloc announced on 3 April. Settling for a smaller group to move forward on a long divisive issue indicates that the EU is now willing to embrace a multi-speed Europe as a way to strengthen Brussels after the shock of Brexit.

### New Anti-Forgery €50 Note Launched



A new €50 note was launched in the 19 eurozone countries on 3 April featuring a host of innovative touches designed to make it harder to forge. The new orange-coloured note issued by the European Central Bank incorporates a transparent window featuring a picture of "Europa", a goddess from Greek mythology, on a metallic strip. In another forgery-busting move, the figures five and zero on the note are emerald-coloured but change colour when it is moved

from side to side.

### Security Is Risky Card for Britain in Brexit Talks, Analysts Say



From sharing intelligence after terror attacks to pursuing cross-border criminals, security is a potential bargaining chip for Britain in the Brexit negotiations - but one that must be played carefully, analysts say. Prime Minister Theresa May warned the European Union on 29 March that failing to reach a new trade deal once Britain leaves the bloc could damage cooperation against crime and terrorism. The government denied it was a threat, saying it was simply fact that unless Britain agreed to continue its security cooperation projects, including with law enforcement agency Europol, then it would leave them after Brexit.
