Spain to Fine Large Firms that Fail to Notify Authorities of Cyberattacks



The Spanish government plans to penalize companies that provide essential services, such as electricity and transportation, as well as digital service providers if they fail to promptly notify authorities of major cyberattacks. Action will also be taken if companies do not take appropriate measures to avoid these kinds of attacks. The sanctions are said to be "effective, proportionate and dissuasive." This is according to a draft law proposed by the Spanish government that aims to bring the country in line with the European Union's Directive on the security of network and information systems (NIS Directive).

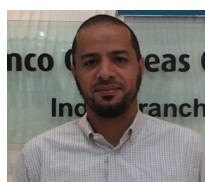
