The ASIS International Israel Chapter Conference was held on 25 August at the Israel Export Institute in Tel Aviv. There were 15 participants in attendance.



### Security Spotlight Focuses on Active Shooters

# SECURITY SPOTLIGHT

On 14 August, pandemonium broke out at one of New York City's Kennedy International Airport's terminals when passengers allegedly heard what sounded like gunfire. As the rumour spread, hordes of people began running and screaming, fearing that an active shooter was on the loose. In the end, fortunately, there was no shooter and no major injuries.

According to a subsequent editorial in *The New York Times*, the episode had one useful upside: it exposed flaws in airport security, as officials from a host of agencies seemed confused about the security protocols and chain of command. Subsequent inquiries will focus on the placement of cameras, proper drills, and communication among the agencies and to passengers.

If just the thought of a nearby active shooter can cause widespread panic, companies cannot ignore their obligation to prepare and train their employees on how to react if the rumour is true. ### European Regulators to Scrutinise WhatsApp Privacy Switch



Facebook's move to relax the privacy policy of WhatsApp, the world's most popular mobile messaging application, will be closely scrutinised, the chair of Europe's leading group of privacy regulators has said. WhatsApp, which counts more than a billion users globally, announced it would start sharing users' phone numbers with Facebook, helping it to target advertisements and friend recommendations across the social media network. It said that WhatsApp users could choose not to share their account information with Facebook.

The leaders of Italy, France and Germany vowed to boost joint European security efforts in the wake of Islamic extremist attacks as they made a symbolic bid to relaunch the European Union after Britain's vote to leave.

From the deck of the Italian aircraft carrier Garibaldi, which is spearheading the EU's migrant rescue and anti-smuggling effort, Italian Premier Matteo Renzi, German Chancellor Angela Merkel and French President Francois Hollande also promised new economic prospects to young people -- albeit without any specific proposals or details.

The three leaders travelled to the sun-soaked island of Ventotene to pay tribute to one of the founding fathers of European unity, Altiero Spinelli, and show common cause going into a bigger EU-wide summit next month in Slovakia.

Spinelli, along with another intellectual confined to Ventotene in the 1940s by Italy's fascist rulers, cowrote the "Ventotene Manifesto" calling for a federation of European states to counter the nationalism that had led Europe to war. The document is considered the inspiration for European federalism.

### EU Backs Franco-German Bid for Access to Encrypted Messages



French intelligence services, on high alert since attackers killed hundreds of civilians in Paris in November and in Nice in July, are struggling to intercept messages from Islamist militants. Many of the groups now use encrypted messaging services rather than mainstream social media, with Islamic State a big user of such apps, investigators in several countries have said.

French Interior Minister Bernard Cazeneuve said the European Commission should draft a law obliging operators to cooperate in investigations of militants. "If such legislation was adopted, this would allow us to impose obligations at the European level on noncooperative operators," he told a joint conference with his German counterpart in Paris. The European Commission said it welcomed the Franco-German initiatives. An existing online privacy framework is already under review, it said.

### Stockpile Food in Case of Attack, Germany Tells Citizens

On 24 August, Germany urged its population to stockpile food and water in case of terrorist or cyberattacks, as it adopted its first civil defence strategy since the end of the Cold War. The plan marks the first broad update since 1995, when a dismantling of federal civil defence structures was advocated as security policies were eased in the wake of German reunification. But the 69-page document warned, "The security policy environment has changed again."

### **UK's New EU Commissioner Given Security Portfolio**

Britain's new European commissioner has been given a narrow brief covering organised crime and counterterrorism issues, as Brussels moved to settle the delicate issue of how to allocate responsibilities to a commissioner from a country on course to exit the EU. The EU's executive arm said that Sir Julian King would be handed the role of "commissioner for the security union," while making clear that the role would be tightly defined and largely focused on operational measures rather than policymaking.


