

Below are a few of the suggestions I have from the workshop:

- Change the terminology from Active Shooter to **Active Threat**. The evolving issue is much more broad than just gunfire.
- Narrow the focus of the joint venture to address pre-response issues. Many departments and organizations already address the response end of the issues. I believe the event initiation to the threat elimination timeframe should be the focus of this endeavor.
- Develop a small working group to identify the laws, regulations, codes, standards and practices that need adjustment to enhance saving lives during these events.
- Establish a priority list of what needs to be addressed first to last that will affect the saving lives purpose of the joint venture.
- Set a timeline for completion of the task associated with the Active Threat standards development.
