Scope: Standard will provide generic management requirements for PSO selection and training processes as well as guidance for good practices related to the selection, training, and use of private security officers. Generic parameters will address issues related to elements common to any program for managing the selection and training processes, while guidance will outline what is considered industry good practice. Standard is not intended for third-party certification of private security companies.
