

Certification Accelerator Scholarship Program

A gift from your ASIS Foundation

In 2022, the ASIS Foundation will award one free certification exam—either the CPP, PSP, PCI or APP—to up to 100 ASIS Chapters around the world. Scholarships were given to members in 39 countries last year.

Three easy steps for chapters to participate:

- 1. Decide how to select your winner. Options include:
 - Application process. Ask members to apply with the chapter for the scholarship then evaluate the applications and select a winner. Sample guidelines and application are available at asisfoundation.org.
 - *Random selection*. Identify all chapter members eligible for certification, then randomly select a winner from that group.
- 2. Publicize the scholarship competition to your members. Post information on your website and/or Connects community and announce at meetings/webinars and/or e-mail your members the details and deadline.
- 3. Select your winner and notify the Foundation. Enter your scholarship recipient's contact information in the Certification Accelerator portal on the ASIS Foundation website by 31 October 2022. The first 100 chapters to submit a winner will receive the scholarship, so submit your recipient early! Then notify all your applicants of the results. You may also create and award a certificate to your winner. Templates available at asisfoundation.org.

Once you submit your winner's name, the Foundation will do the rest. We will contact the scholarship recipient with instructions on how to claim the scholarship and apply for certification. Winners will receive a unique voucher code that will allow them to apply and take the ASIS certification exam of their choice at no charge.

Please note: the scholarship does not guarantee that the recipient will be approved to take the exam or will achieve their certification.

Scholarship recipients must be selected in accordance with the ASIS Foundation scholarship policy using a fair, objective and non-discriminatory process. Winners will be selected without regard to race, age, gender, religion, political beliefs, employment status, or any other factors that constitute unfair or illegal discrimination.
