All applicants must answer the following questions to qualify for the scholarship. Failure to answer a question may automatically eliminate you from consideration. Please attach your response to this application and submit.

1. Describe your accomplishments and state why you are a strong candidate for this scholarship.
2. Describe how this ASIS certification will benefit you and help you achieve your career goals. How will you use this knowledge in your profession/career.
3. Describe your involvement and activities within your chapter.
4. Submit a letter of recommendation from your council officer if you are an ASIS Council member. If not a member of an ASIS Council, submit letter of recommendation from your chapter chair.
5. Submit a current resume.

## Conditions

- The ASIS Foundation "Career Development Scholarship" is open to all ASIS Members in good standing. Members of Women in Security and Young Professionals Councils are particularly encouraged to apply.
- The Career Development Scholarships include the online CPP Review Course, the online PSP Review Course, or the PCI Reference Set and a Certification Voucher that is good for one year from the date of the scholarship. The Certification Voucher covers the application costs for the certification exam. The Foundation Certification Voucher does not guarantee that the recipient is eligible to take the test. Test applicants must apply, be qualified, and if deemed eligible will receive an approval letter that provides up to two years to complete the ASIS Certification exam. Please be sure to review the ASIS Board Certification Handbook and utilize the Self-Assessment Guide available on the ASIS certification web page: <https://www.asisonline.org/certify>
- Applicants must be committed to obtaining an ASIS certification.
- Applicants must not have received this scholarship in the past.
- The ASIS Foundation Scholarship Committee will review and make the final selections based on the completed information provided by the applicant. A total of six scholarships will be offered in 2018.
- Student members, national officers, ASIS directors, and relatives of the ASIS Foundation Board of Trustees are ineligible for the award.
- ASIS Career Development Scholarships sponsored by the ASIS Foundation are not transferable.

Subject to the ASIS Foundation stated scholarship criteria, winning applicants will be selected on an objective and non-discriminatory basis, without regard to race, age, gender, religion, political beliefs, employment status, or any other factors that constitute unfair or illegal discrimination.
