## Applications accepted between 1 April and 31 May 2018.

**PURPOSE:** The ASIS Foundation is committed to supporting ASIS members by providing scholarships that help individuals achieve their professional goals in the security and related professions. Through a partnership between the ASIS Foundation and the Military Liaison Council, scholarships will be offered in 2018 to provide a set of certification reference materials, an online certification review course (available for CPP and PSP only), and to provide a voucher that will enable thawe scholarship recipient to apply to take the examination for a specific ASIS Certification.

## To qualify, you must:

- Be active duty, national guard, or reserve military assigned to the armed forces of any nation
- Be an ASIS member in good standing
- Be prepared to meet the requirements of the ASIS board certification for which you are applying

## Your complete application must include:

- 1. Nomination letter signed by department/agency chief or director
- 2. A 250 to 300-word essay to explain why you are a strong candidate and the reason you are applying for this scholarship (1-page, double-spaced, 12 pt. Arial / Times New Roman)
- 3. Resume or CV
