- 2. Describe how this ASIS certification will benefit you and help you achieve your career goals, including how you will use this knowledge in your profession/career.
- 3. Describe your involvement and activities within your chapter.
- 4. Submit a letter or recommendation from a chapter leader, employer, or superior on the individual's letterhead with his/her signature.

Conditions

- Formally known as the Allan J. Cross Award The ASIS Foundation "Road to Certification Scholarships" are open to all ASIS members in good standing. Only one individual from each chapter may receive the scholarship.
- Twenty "Road to Certification Scholarships" will be offered in 2018. Selected recipients will receive either the CPP or PSP Online Review Course, or the PCI Reference Set.
- The ASIS Foundation Scholarship Committee will review and make the final awards based on the completed information provided by the applicant. 20 applications will be awarded in 2018 from all the applications received between **1** April **31** May **2018**.
 - Note: This award is no longer awarded based on the first 20 applicants received, but rather on qualifications and information submitted and reviewed by the Foundation Scholarship Committee.
- The chapter chair, regional vice president, or senior regional vice president when a member is unaffiliated, must sign, fax, or email the completed application.
- The recipient must be a member in good standing who has not previously received a Cross Scholarship.
- Student members, national officers, ASIS directors, and relatives of the ASIS Foundation Board of Trustees are ineligible for the award.

Subject to the ASIS Foundation stated scholarship criteria, winning applicants will be selected on an objective and non-discriminatory basis, without regard to race, age, gender, religion, political beliefs, employment status, or any other factors that constitute unfair or illegal discrimination.
