 - Who is the intended audience?
 - Why is this education topic current in today's environment?
 - How would this program expand your chapter's impact on the membership, community outreach, and the security profession?
 - Explain how this effort fits within the chapter's current strategic plan?
 - How will your chapter effectively market the program, and will it be offered to outside public/ private organizations?
- 3. Please provide a budget estimate for your chapter's marketing, event costs, educational materials and handouts.
- 4. The grant **only** covers faculty stipend, transportation and accommodations costs for two days up to \$10,000.
