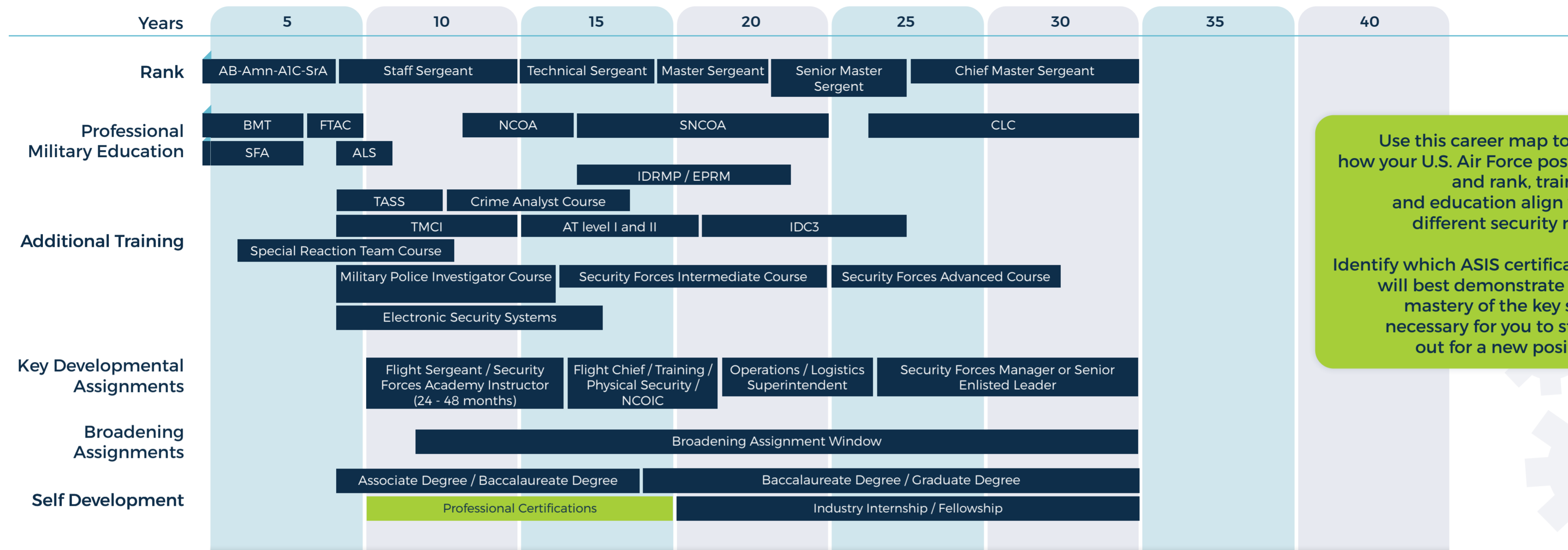

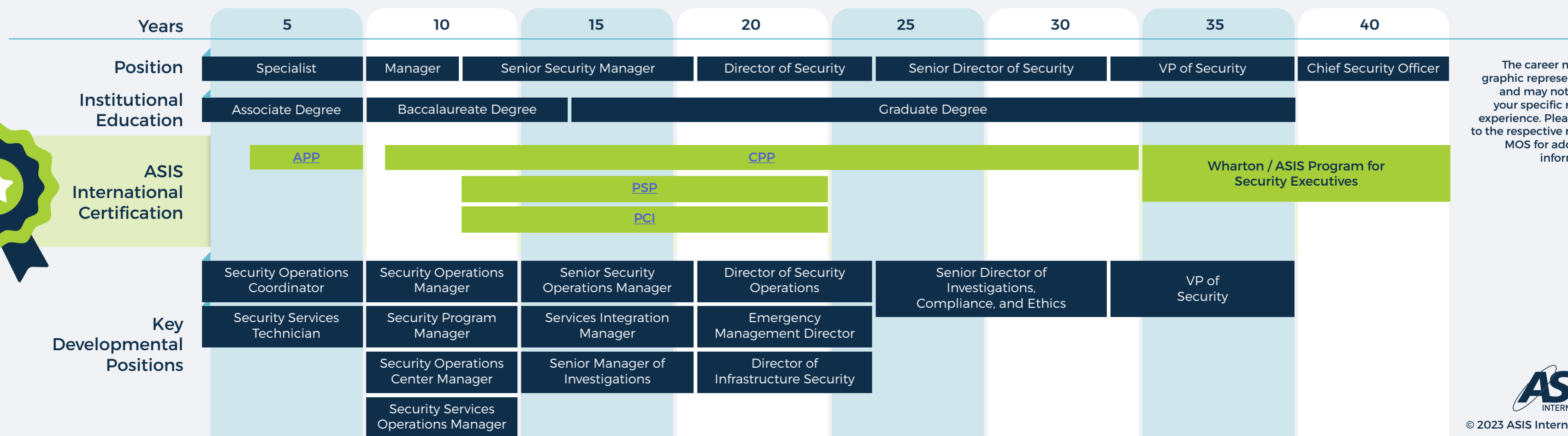

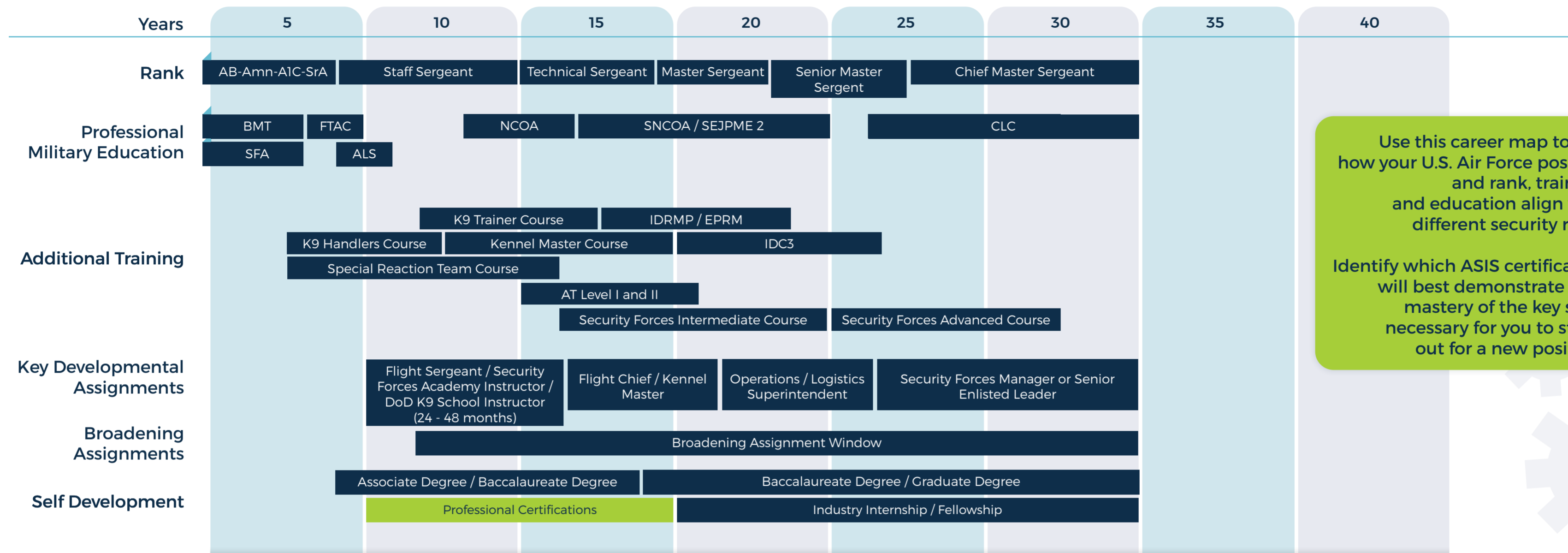

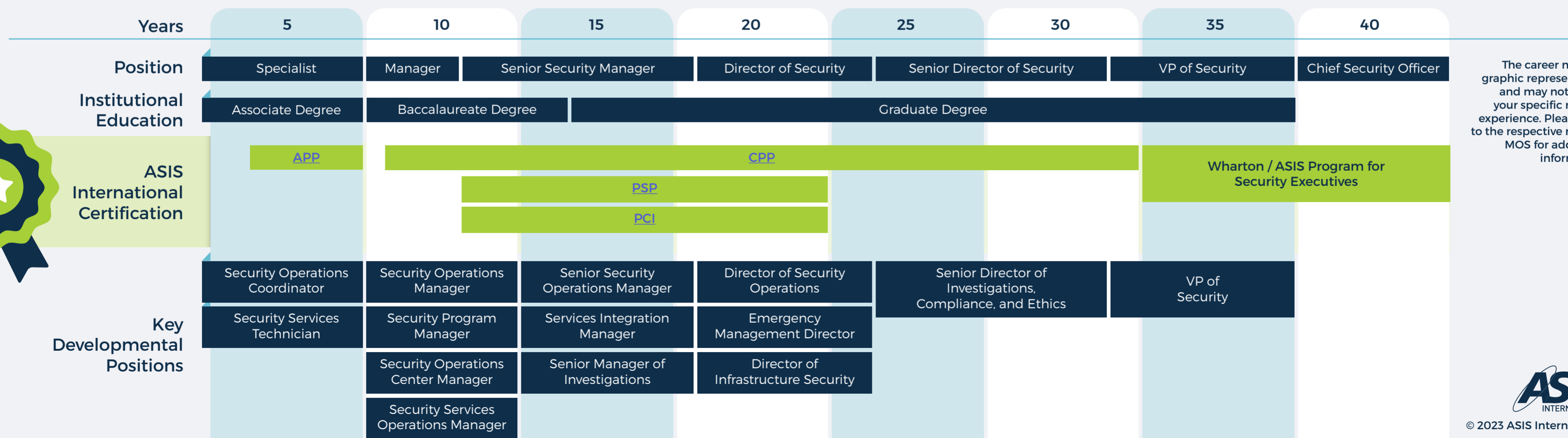
Security Forces K9 Handler Career Development (3P0X1A)

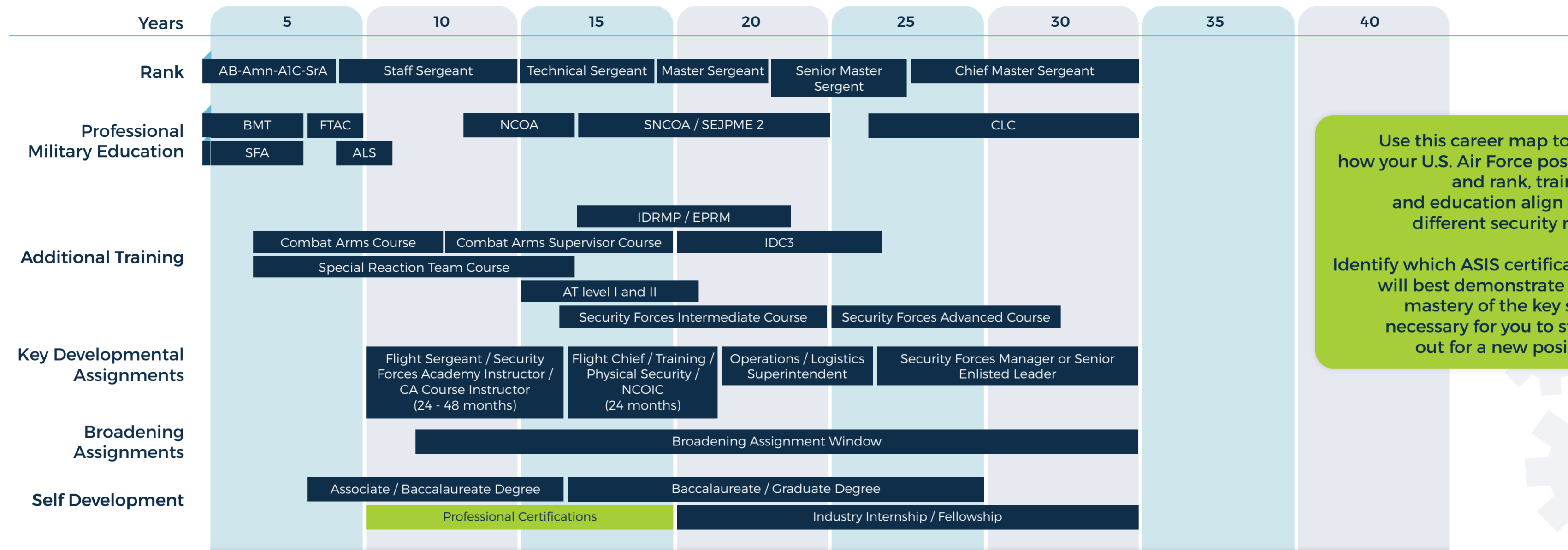

MILITARY TO CIVILIAN CAREER MAP: U.S. AIR FORCE NONCOMMISSIONED OFFICER

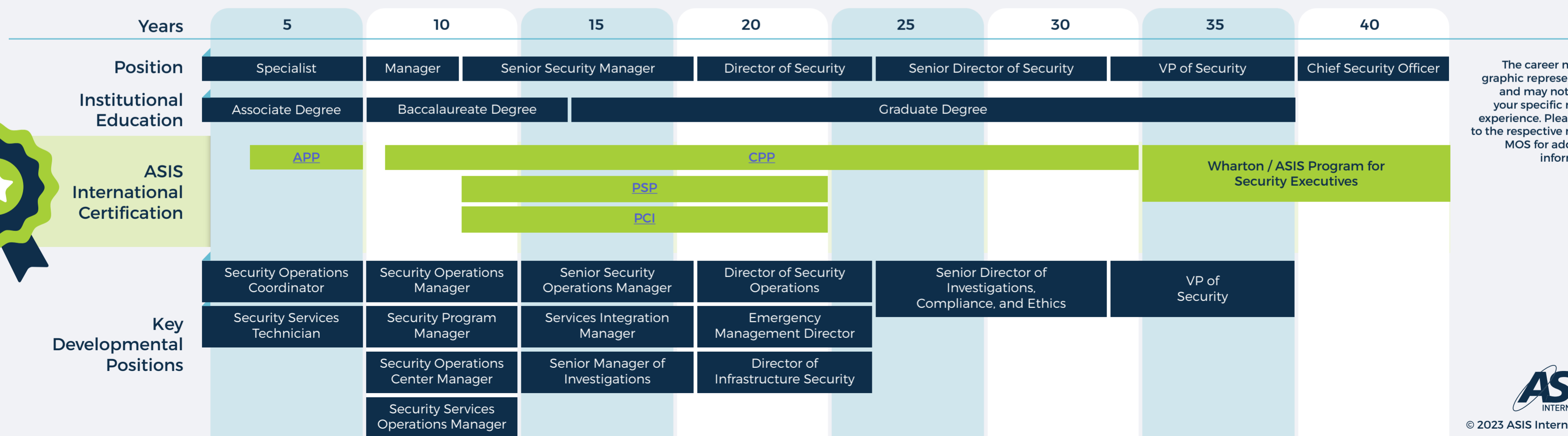
Security Forces Combat Arms Career Development (3P0X1B)
