- 1955** ASIS Annual Seminar holds first show
- 1966** ASIS Foundation launched
- 1957** First issue of Industrial Security magazine published
- 1977** Certified Protection Professional (CPP) certification launched
- 1972** Industrial Security renamed Security Management
- 2002** Name changed from ASIS to ASIS International; "Advancing Security Worldwide" tagline adopted
- 1989** First woman named president of Board of Directors (Darlene Sherwood, CPP)
- 2003** Professional Certified Investigator (PCI) and Physical Security Professional (PSP) certifications launched
- 2008** ASIS International became an American National Standards Institute (ANSI) accredited Standards Developer
- 2018** ASIS Annual Seminar and Exhibits re-branded as Global Security Exchange (GSX); Associate Protection Professional (APP) certification launched
